Middle School Arts Opportunities

Students in the Middle School have an opportunity to choose semester or year-long electives in the performing and visual arts. In the performing arts, the electives are Band, Chorus, Dance, Debate, Guitar, Speech, Strings, Theatre Arts, and Thespians. In the visual arts, students can choose from electives in Ceramics, Digital Photography, Drawing and Painting, and TV Production. After school, Middle School students can audition for or join one of our performing arts ensembles or productions, such as Dance Company, Drum Line, the fall musical, or the spring play. The Film & TV Production students work in the studio to create and edit

public service announcements for contests and community service projects. Students also have the opportunity to join the Speech and Debate Team. Finally, our 7th and 8th grade visual arts students have the opportunity to earn membership in the National Junior Art Honor Society.
