NSU University School serves as a TEST CENTER for the Secondary School Admission Test (SSAT) with the option to test on an Alternate Flex Date (weekdays). The SSAT is the same regardless of test date. The advantage for applicants to take the SSAT on an Alternate Flex Date is the opportunity to tour the school as well as complete the Student Interview at the conclusion of the test.

\*Saturday Standard SSAT testing dates are available at local and international testing sites- Please note that the school tour and student interview, live or via Zoom, will be scheduled on a separate date for NSU University School applicants.

- Go to [www.ssat.org](http://www.ssat.org) to create an account with SSAT and register for a test
- *VERY IMPORTANT: Save your Username and Password for future SSAT account management*
- Please contact the NSU University School admissions office by phone at 954-262-4506 or by email at [uschooladmissions@nova.edu](mailto:uschooladmissions@nova.edu) to request an access code for a specific test month in order to register your child for SSAT Flex testing on our campus. Access codes are not required for Saturday tests or SSAT at Home.

- Click on **YES** when asked: **Would you like to add Score Recipients at this stage?**
- Type in **NSU University School or test center 7857**, click **Add**
- Select any desired optional items. *Note that you can access your Score Report FREE through your SSAT account once scores become available.*
- **Confirm Your Choices and Proceed to Payment**
- Print your SSAT confirmation ticket
