## Upper School Arts Opportunities



Students in the Upper School have an opportunity to take semester or year-long electives in the performing and visual arts. In the performing arts, students can choose from electives in Acting, Band, Chorus, Dance, Debate, Guitar, Music Theory, Strings, and even Stagecraft. In the visual arts, students can choose from electives in Ceramics, Digital Photography, Drawing and Painting, and Film & TV Production. After school, Upper School students can audition for or join one of our performing arts ensembles or productions, such as Dance Company, Drum Line, the fall play, winter musical, or smaller theatrical productions through the Thespian Troupe, which also provides the students with the opportunity to compete in individual and group district and state competitions. Students in Band, Chorus, Dance, and Strings perform at two concerts per year and also participate in regional festivals and statewide workshops. The Speech and Debate team has several competitions throughout the year and members of the team travel to regional and national competitions. Our Film & TV Production students can work in the studio to create and edit films for contests and community service projects. Students also have the opportunity to earn membership in the International Thespian Society, National Art Honor Society, National Honor Society for Dance Arts, National Forensic League, and Tri-M Music Honor Society.
